Archery Basic Instruction Course

Perhaps you've never shot a bow before or maybe you've had a go at archery at an activity day or while on holiday and want to expand it to a hobby. Either way we welcome anybody who wants to try archery with a view to taking up the sport and joining our club. The aim of the course is to show you how to set up and use a basic recurve bow and shoot it safely. Remember Bows and Arrows were the choice weapon for many years!

Starting date and time

Beginner's courses are run outdoors between April and October. Typically, courses consist of three two-hour sessions. We may vary on the day of the week and the start times, these depend on the course leader availability, the natural light and weather; although winter courses are available at an extra cost to cover the venue hire.

Our courses are very popular and often over- subscribed. The numbers are limited and so we cannot accommodate new trainees on a course once it has started. However, we do run a waiting list system for those people who apply and will fit you in a course to suit you as soon as we can.

The course consists of three sessions of 2 hours each, if it's necessary to cancel a lesson due to bad weather, or if you know in advance that you'll miss a particular week (e.g., if you are on holiday), then it can be made up later. Please note though, we can only make up one missed lesson – so if you know you will have to miss more lessons then we advise to wait for a later course. If you're unable to attend a particular lesson, please let us know beforehand. We cannot accept beginners into the Club unless they have attended all sessions.

Cost

The fee for the full outdoor course is £30.00 per person, we ask that you pay a deposit of £20.00 and the remainder at the first session.

The fee covers all the equipment and access you will need for its duration.

Juniors

<u>Juniors between 7 and 11 years old</u> a separate course arrangement is run for this age group, please use the contact form or speak to the club secretary for suitability and advice.

<u>Juniors 12 and above</u> can apply to join the beginner's course. However, acceptance of each junior on the course is subject to the approval of the coach. We can assess this prior to booking a place on a course, please ask for details. **Juniors must be accompanied by parents, or parentally approved guardians, at all times, when on the archery range / club.**

Equipment

We provide all the equipment required for the course. Please, **do not buy any equipment** yourselves before you have at least tried our basic course. If you have your own equipment already we can make an assessment on its suitability, should you wish. If you join the club after the course, the course leaders and club members can offer advice to help you purchase your own equipment.

Clothing

You should wear comfortable but close-fitting clothing. If it's chilly it's better to wear several thin layers rather than one bulky one and perhaps bring a woolly hat. In particular it's important that you don't wear jumpers or jackets with baggy sleeves as bow strings tend to catch on them & spoil your shot! For the same reasons and for personal safety you should remove any jewellery or personal body piercing that might be caught by the bow string. Long hair should also be tied back.

Where

Norfolk Bowmen shoot outdoors at Long Meadow Rectory Road, Western Longville, NR9 6LF / NR9 6LG (we're on the boarder of the two codes). We have a sign and targets are set up most of the time to help you find us. You can also search for "Norfolk Bowmen" on Google Maps.

Contact

Club secretary is the main contact prior to your course and after you have started, the course leader will be, details of which are on the web site.

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Terms and Conditions

- An application form must be completed and either sent to the e-mail address on the form or handed to the course
 leader in person before starting the course.
- Juniors (any person under the age of 18) must be accompanied by an appropriate adult.
- All medical disclosures relevant to the sport of archery must be indicated at that time.
- All course fees must be paid in full by the start of the second lesson.
- Deposits must be received 1 week before the start of the course.
- Your place will only be confirmed once the deposit has been received.
- Instruction course fees and deposits are non-refundable.
- Instruction course fees do not entitle you to membership of Norfolk Bowmen.
- All coaching and shooting will be strictly in accordance with Archery GB rules, regulations and practice. Any
 contravention of shooting or safety rules will result in immediate suspension from the session.
- Norfolk Bowmen retain the right to refuse further access to the beginner's course if students persistently disobey the safety instructions or the rules of shooting.
- Norfolk Bowmen cannot accept any responsibility for damage or injury sustained whilst entering, or leaving, the ground.
